

Extra Credit Film Review - Chimpanzee



Disney's *Chimpanzee* tells the story of orphaned chimp, Oscar. Given what you have learned about chimpanzee social organization, chimpanzee behavior, and the social and emotional bonds they form from the lecture material and from watching the National Geographic film, "Among the Wild Chimpanzees," you should have an appreciation for the remarkable relationship that develops between Oscar and an adult male chimp that takes him under his wing.



After watching the film, you should be able to provide examples of chimp behavior and social organization including: territoriality, tool use, food foraging activities, social bonds, social organization including the dominance hierarchy, and why Oscar's story is so amazing.

In addition, your own reactions to the film and any important or interesting things you learned should also be included in your review. Please don't describe the film in your review---I have already seen it. I am most interested in your perspective, thoughts, and reactions to this endearing story.

Your review should be at least 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 pages in length. Typed, double spaced and 1 inch margins on all sides.

This assignment is worth up to 25 points extra credit depending on the quality of the review.
