

Primate Observations – Extra Credit Assignment

Instructions: Using your lecture notes that outline the defining characteristics of Primates, go to a local park, grocery store or coffee shop to do some field observations of human primates in action. The goal is to record *as many different displays of Primate characteristics as possible* during your observational session. Plan on spending at least 45 minutes doing your observations and recording data. Bring a notebook, your lecture notes and a timer, and refrain from engaging in any other activities during your observation period. You will then type up a report describing your findings.

This assignment is worth up to 25 extra credit points, depending on the quality of the report.
